Eligibility for Graduate Research/Teaching Assistantship Award

To be eligible for a Graduate Research/Teaching Assistantship, students must meet the following minimum requirements.

- 1. At least a 3.0 undergraduate GPA
- 2. Enrolled as a full-time student (9 semester hours)
- 3. Not employed full-time
- 4. Available for work Monday Fri. 9:00am to 5:00pm (business hours) except for scheduled classes
- 5. Facility in written and spoken English please provide a 2-to-3-page writing sample

Applications for a graduate assistantship should be submitted by May 15th for the Fall Semester and October 15th for the Spring semester. As a rule, graduate assistantship awards begin in the Fall semester for an academic year.

Additional Criteria for Graduate Research/Teaching Assistantship Award

- 1. Academic Performance in undergraduate and graduate studies.
- 2. SPA/Faculty needs
- 3. Progress toward degree (if already enrolled)
- 4. Diversity in assistantship pool
- 5. Student Financial Need

Appointment for Graduate Research/Teaching Assistantship Award

The Director of the SPA, in consultation with the SPA faculty, makes all Graduate Research/Teaching Assistantship appointments. Graduate Assistantships may be renewed for up to two years contingent on good academic standing, satisfactory evaluations from supervisors, SPA need, and available financing.

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
